<p>Health Insurance</p>	<p>Each student is responsible for purchasing health insurance for the entire stay in Poland.</p> <p>Students from the European Union or the European Economic Area should ask insurance companies in their countries about providing them with the European Health Insurance Cards (EHIC), which entitle them to essential healthcare. It is highly recommended to arrange additional commercial insurance.</p> <p>Non EU citizens are obliged to have life and health insurance policies which ensure at least the following health care services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • emergency medical assistance costs; • treatment costs of growing chronic illness; • transport costs to the closest medical facility providing the services mentioned above; • transportation costs to return to one's home country in case of a serious illness or death. <p>Non EU citizens can get the above-mentioned insurance policy at local insurance companies at their home countries.</p>
<p>Visa</p>	<p>Students who need visas to enter Poland must obtain them by their own means and may use acceptance letters sent from our university.</p> <p>Further assistance: international@ujd.edu.pl</p>
<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>All international students can apply for a single or double room at the Student Dormitory "Skrzat" located at 76/78 Dąbrowskiego St. – near the city centre, from where you can easily walk to any facility belonging to the University.</p> <p>The prices for accommodation are the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 400 PLN per month for one place in a single room, • 300 PLN per month for one place in a double room. <p>Free access to the Internet is available in each room, however the access is via cable (please ask for connection cable at the reception).</p>

<p>Transportation</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Transportation from the Airport:</p> <p>To get to Częstochowa you should choose the nearest airport Katowice (KTW) which is located 36.4 km from Częstochowa. Other nearby airports include Krakow (KRK) (93.8 km), Wrocław (WRO) (160.9 km), Warsaw Chopin (WAW) (199.5 km) and Warsaw Modlin (WMI) (211.5 km). The city of Częstochowa is reached at best price by coach, mini-bus or train.
